Patient Catering Orange Juice update/ Hypo Boxes / Texture Modified Diets Owing to a global shortage of fresh fruit juice the normal 1 litre ambient (don't require refrigeration) containers of orange juice and 1 litre containers of apple juice are not currently available from any of our suppliers. An alternative supply of apple juice has not been sourced; we understand new supplies are expected some time next week. National Procurement have sourced an alternative fresh orange juice in 2.25litre (milk style containers). These larger cartons are not an ambient product and must be stored within the ward pantry fridges when not in use. Supplies of pineapple juice are not affected.

Actions for inpatient areas:

- 1. The replacement orange juice has small bits of orange within it and would not be suitable for texture modified patients. An alternative orange juice has been sourced for texture modified diets: "Calypso" smooth orange juice in 200ml cartons. Please decant into a cup for patients.
- 2. The replacement orange juice is **not suitable** for hypo box use as the carbohydrate content is not sufficient. The 200ml Calypso orange should be used instead.

200ml cartons of Calypso orange juice is available **on request** from the catering department, for texture modified diets and hypo boxes **only.** We apologise for these shortages, which are outwith our control. The catering team will advise when stock issues are resolved.
