Chief Executive's Team update We are pleased to confirm June Brown (Executive Nurse Director) will take on the role of deputy Chief Executive, with immediate effect, to support Adam Coldwells in his role as interim Chief Executive. June's role as Senior Responsible Officer for the Baird & ANCHOR Project will pass to Prof Nick Fluck (Medical Director) effective from Wednesday 10 April.

Reminder - retail catering - price increase Unfortunately, due to the continued high cost of food and beverages, there will be a small increase in prices at all retail catering outlets from **next Monday (8 April)**. From now on, prices charged will track the Consumer Price Index, allowing the retail catering outlets to charge a fair price for the drinks, snacks, and meals they produce and help the service breakeven as it is required to do.

From Monday, a large latte from Aroma will cost £2.70 (£2.45 staff price), a muffin will cost on average £2.00 (increase of 5p). There will be no change in the price of sandwiches. You can continue to get a discount on all hot drinks in any unit by bringing your own cup, please ensure it is clean. Main meals in the cafes will increase by between 10-15p and will typically cost between £2.80-£4.15, depending on your order. There will also be a slight increase in the cost of hospitality catering; please ensure you use the correct booking form, available on the Catering intranet page (networked devices only).

When Central Stores orders go astray In an organisation as big as ours there is always the chance of a Central Stores order being delivered accidentally to the wrong location. If you have had items misdelivered to your department, labelled for another area, please contact your local porters or transport to have them collected and delivered to the correct area. You should state these have been delivered to the wrong location, giving them your location and the labelled location of the order, so redelivery can be arranged. Stores cages should also be returned to Central Stores as soon as possible. This will avoid having to condense cages for larger areas which can lead to mis-deliveries.
