
## COVID-19Brief



Here is the brief for Wednesday 21 April 2021.

**Grampian data** The local figures for today and the 7-day rolling positivity rate are shown below. As a reminder, this rate is arrived at by dividing the number of positive tests in the past 7 days by the number of tests carried out in the past 7 days. Repeat tests are included in both categories, whereas the figures we show here only record new tests.



If you are interested in seeing what is happening in your area, this information is published daily by Public Health Scotland. All you need to do is click <a href="here">here</a> and select the appropriate local authority area.

**Review of Minimum Education and Training Standards in Nursing and Midwifery** We shared a draft version of the briefing related to this item yesterday – our apologies for any confusion caused. The correct version has been attached to the email used to send this brief, a reminder that this survey from the NMC is open until 11 May. Full details are included in the briefing document.

**ARI Roof Garden & Sanctuary – change in usage guidelines** With the easing of restrictions and a phased return of in-person hospital visiting from 26 April, the following are the guidelines for the use of the above spaces until further notice:

- Roof Garden We ask that no more than 12 people at any given time are in the Roof Garden.
  Priority should be given to patients, relatives and any staff who are working with them. While staff
  may still use the Roof Garden for their own rest periods, they should defer to any patients wishing
  to use the garden. On account of the limitations on numbers we would prefer staff not to eat in
  the Roof Garden.
- Sanctuary No more than 8 people should be in Sanctuary at any given time. Physical distancing
  measures should be observed, and face masks worn. The permission to use the Sanctuary as a
  dining space for Staff is now withdrawn. The Sanctuary will now revert to being a reflective
  space for patients, relatives and staff. Staff should not eat or drink in this space. The Sanctuary
  should not be used by staff on laptops, participating in Teams meetings etc.

**In-person care home visiting** Our colleagues in Aberdeenshire HSCP have developed graphics to raise awareness of the guidelines governing in-person visiting in care homes; please share with colleagues, friends and family as appropriate.


