**Call for all available staff** We are currently facing an extreme level of pressure across our health care system, due to the number of acutely ill patients arriving at hospital and difficulties in discharging patients to community settings. We are asking all staff who are not working - and may be on annual leave - but would be available to work, to contact Site and Capacity, on 54886, as soon as possible.

We appreciate this is a big ask, especially at this time of year, and greatly appreciate any additional support you are able to give.

**Agenda for Change Pay Award** The 2022/23 pay award for Agenda for Change staff <u>Pay and</u> <u>conditions for NHS staff covered by the Agenda for Change agreement (scot.nhs.uk)</u> will be applied in January salaries. Weekly paid bank workers will see the increased rates in wages paid on Friday 13 January 2023. Notification of when arrears will be paid will follow in the next few weeks.

**NHS Mileage Rates** A temporary increase to mileage rates was implemented on 1 April 2022. It has been announced that the rates set out in <u>Temporary increase to NHS Scotland mileage rates</u> will be maintained until such time as the UK Staff Council agrees a revised system for reimbursing travel costs.
