Piper Alpha Anniversary Today marks the 34th anniversary of the Piper Alpha disaster. The effects of the tragedy, which remains the most significant offshore incident in history, are still being felt by survivors and the friends, families and loves ones of those who were on board on that fateful day in 1988.

Many of our colleagues were integral to response that night, providing vital care and support at the time and in the aftermath. It has left a significant impact on so many across the north-east and we hope you will join us in taking a moment today to pause, reflect and pay your respect to those who lost their lives.

Covid update You will not have missed the updates in the media about infection levels continuing to increase in Scotland and the UK. The Office of National Statistics estimate that 1 in 18 people in Scotland had covid on the 7 days to 24th June, up from 1 in 20 the week before. Approx 18% of these are reinfections so just because you have had it before, doesn't mean you can't catch it again. We have been seeing the impact in hospital too.

Covid admissions rose last week, averaging 13 a day over the past week. Covid hospital occupancy continues to increase - a daily average of 103 over the 7 days, compared to 85 last week. This continuing burden of covid comes at a time when the system remains under severe pressure.

Thank you for everything you are doing to reduce the spread of transmission at this challenging time, including wearing masks in healthcare settings and in crowded indoor places.
