NHS Grampian Laundry Services NHS Grampian's laundry services is still in contingency due to the isolated asbestos incident last weekend.

Whilst the laundry is still processing orders across NHS Grampian, they are also being supported in the turnaround of clean linen by other NHS boards and external accredited laundries.

What can you do to help?

- We ask services to be mindful around the use of linen (paper for spills not towels)
- Scrubs must only be worn by appropriate services, for example, theatres
- Change beds only when needed, but ensure linen is changed within a seven-day window
- Sewing Room is open as normal and if extra uniform is required due to operational difficulties, please requisition through normal channels
- Be respectful to the team

The Laundry Staff would like to thank services for their patience and understanding around this unprecedented time. We can all be assured everything is being done behind the scenes to keep this pivotal service running.
